

# How to make a clippie

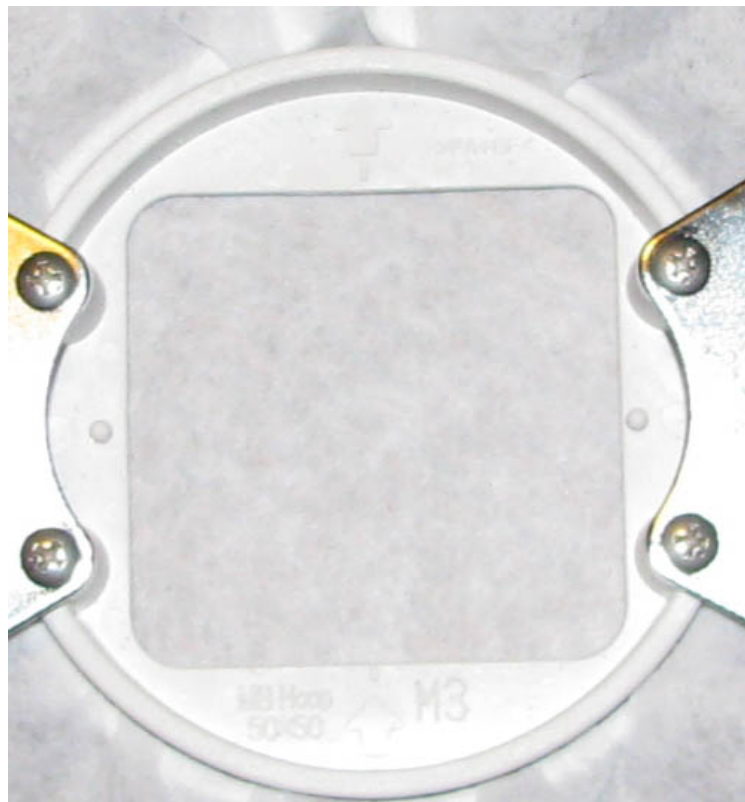
You will need the following supplies to make a clippie-

1. Embroidery machine and ability to transfer design
2. Felt (any type)
3. Embroidery thread
4. Tear away stabilizer
5. Sticky spray adhesive or a washable glue stick

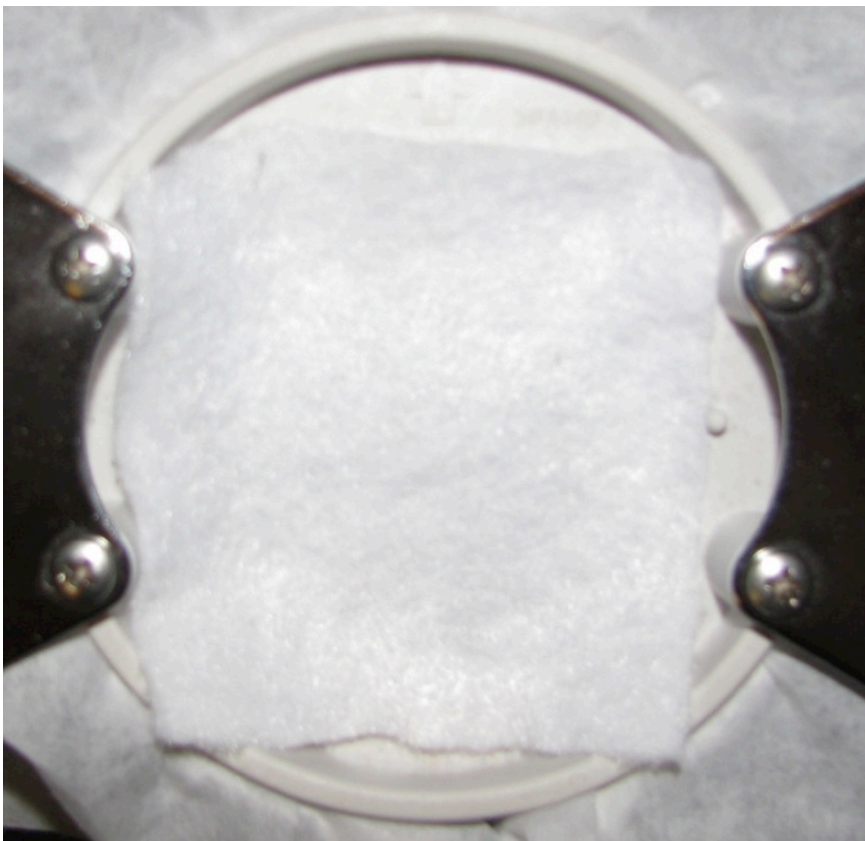
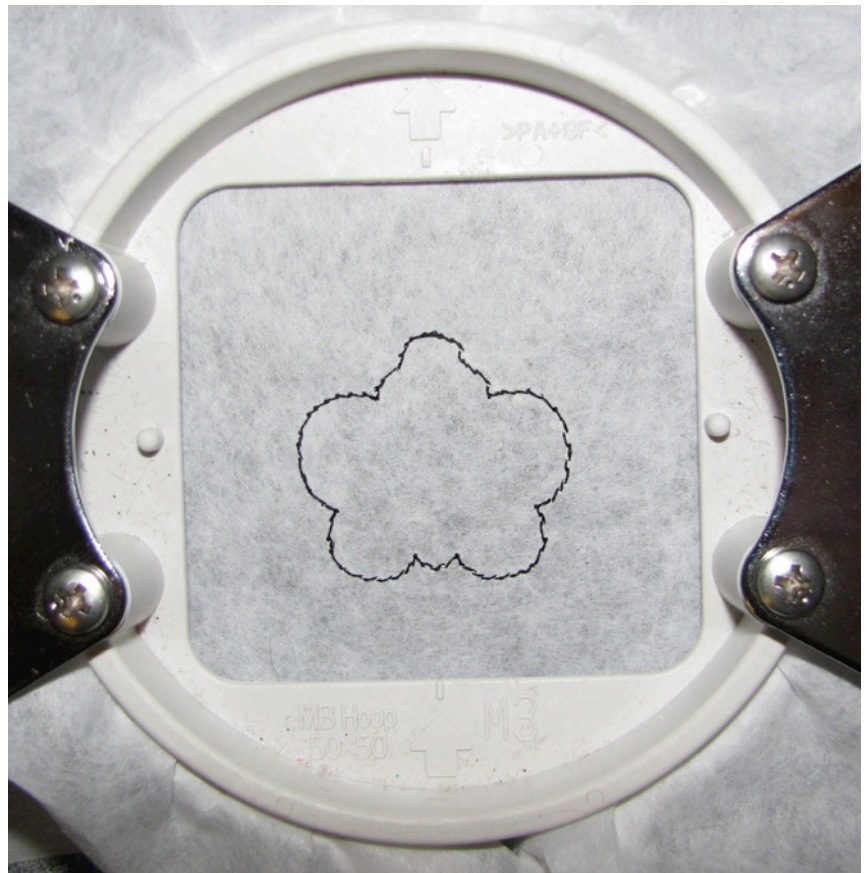
When you open the downloaded zip after you purchase your clippie, there will be a file called "steps" or "stitchingorder" that will show you a step by step picture of what the machine will do. This file is not in a format folder, it is a loose file inside the zip. The "steps" file shows the steps your machine will stitch for your clippie. Each box is one sequence of stitching and after all the stitches shown in the box are completed, your machine will stop. Press the go button on your machine just like in regular embroidery designs to continue to the next step!

Step 1. Choose your felt and thread color and thread your machine. Step one of the design is the outline, this thread color will not show, so you can use any color. I usually suggest starting with the second color of the design so you won't have to change your thread for step two!

Step 2. Hoop your stabilizer.



Step 3. Put your hoop on your machine and let it stitch out the first step directly on the stabilizer. This is the outline stitch for your design so you know where to place your felt.



Step 4. Spray wrong side of felt with sticky spray or lightly coat with glue stick and place it sticky side down on top of stitched outline so it completely covers the outline.

Step 5. Change thread color as you wish and stitch out all



steps EXCEPT for the last step. Use the file labeled "steps" in your zip you downloaded to know which step is last. These steps will stitch out directly on the felt.

Step 6. Spray another piece of felt (for the backing of your clippie) on wrong side with sticky spray or lightly coat with glue stick. Flip hoop over so your design is face down and place this piece of felt (sticky side down) on the back side of stabilizer over outline stitched shape.







Step 7. Place hoop back on machine with felt stuck to bottom side of hooped stabilizer. Change thread color if needed and have machine stitch out the last step of the design.

Step 8. Remove hoop from machine. Take design out of hoop and tear away stabilizer. Cut felt about 1/16 of an inch outside of stitches. Your clippie is done! You can glue or sew it to a snap clip or head band!
