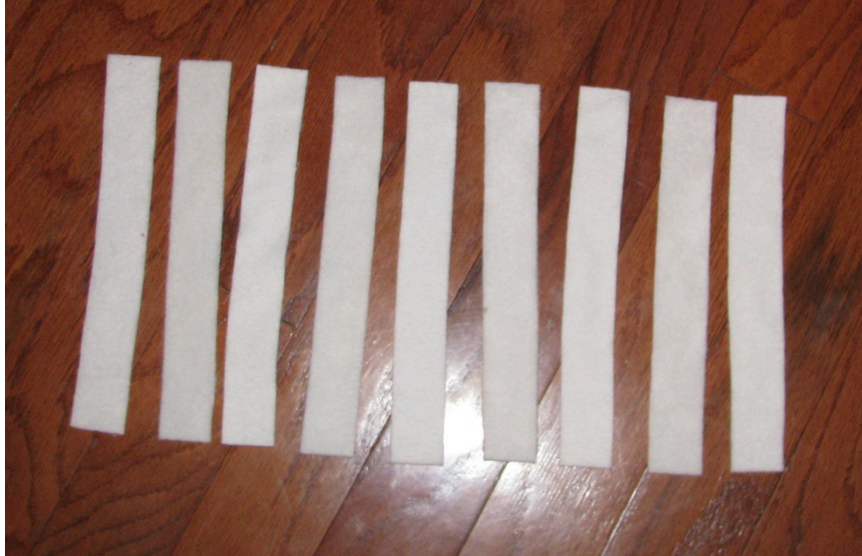


Adding a braid

I used 9 strips of fleece for this braid. I cut 9 strips of fleece that were 1.5" wide and about 8 inches long, but this is obviously a very short braid, so plan for the length based on how long you want it.



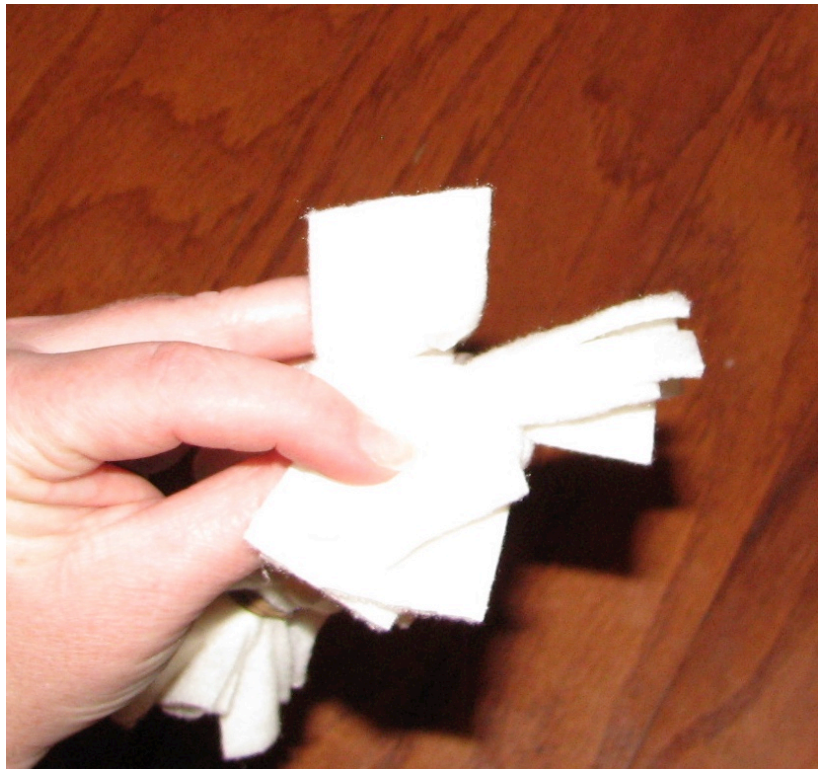
You can use as many or as few pieces of fleece as you would like, just be sure you use equal amounts for each of the 3 sections you are braiding. Divide the pieces into 3 sections.





Braid the sections and tie the end with a ribbon or rubberband or hair tie.

Start with the bottom layer of the braid pieces and hot glue each piece together about 2" from the top of the braid.





Glue all pieces together
EXCEPT the last one,
which should be the top
layer of the braid.

Cut the top 1.5" off of the
braid of all except the last
loose piece, then glue the
last piece on top of the rest
of the pieces, leaving the
1.5" overhang of the last
piece.





Fold the long piece over the back of the braid and hot glue at the very end of the piece of fleece so it makes a small loop over the bunch of pieces.

Now you have a small section, about $\frac{1}{2}$ ", at the top of the braid that is just 2 layers of fleece thick. Put a kamsnap through that small section.



Now you can put a snap on the towel you want and then add your braid!
